



Wheel Assembly Instructions

STEP - 1





ATTACH (P10) WITH WHEEL ASSEMBLY (P9) WITH THE HELP OF (P11) & TIGHTEN IT WITH THE HELP OF HEX SOCKET (P12) AND COVER THE NUT & BOLT AREA WITH THE HELP OF (P25) & MAKE SURE NUT IS NOT TIGHTEN TO MUCH SO THAT PART (P10) STOP ROTATING.
















STEP - 2







FIX THE WHEEL ASSEMBLY (P9)TO BOTH INNER (P7) LEGS OF EACH HALF OF THE TABLE USING NUT & BOLTS (P27) & TIGHTEN IT WITH THE HELP OF 2 SPANNERS.

STEP - 3








ATTACH P31 BETWEEN OUTER LEGS WITH THE HELP OF NUT AND BOLT P30 AND TIGHTEN IT WITH THE

HELP OF TWO SPANNER.

NOW SLIGHTLY PULL OUT THE SIDE LOCK (P23) & SLOWLY BRING DOWN THE TABLE

STEP-6

REPEAT THE SAME FOR THE 2ND HALF OF THE TABLE AS IN STEP- 1, 2, 3 & 4,5

STEP-7



Attach posts to the left and right side of the table.

STEP-8



Place net onto posts, feed string through grooves.

Adjust tension of the net with the chains.

STEP- 9 ADJUST THE HEIGHT REQUIRED WITH THE HELP OF LEVELLERS (P21) ATTACHED ON ALL 4 OUTER LEGS (P6).

YOUR TABLE IS NOW READY FOR PLAY STORING THE TABLE

STEP-1







PULL OUT THE SIDE LOCK (P23) TO LIFT THE TABLE ON THE WHEELS. MAKE SURE THAT LOCK (P22) IS LOCKED PROPERLY FOR STORAGE

STEP-2 REPEAT THE SAME FOR THE 2ND HALF.

<u>Safety Instructions:</u> "Children under 14 years of age should not be allowed to roll out the table, unlock it and place it in the playing position, or close the table and return it to the storage position. When lowering each half of the table top, make sure that the outer legs P6 are pulled gently away from the underside of the table. This table is suitable for both indoor and outdoor use. As far as possible the table should be stored indoors. Always cover the table when not in use. Check the wheel brakes are off when moving the table and they are on again when the table is in the play and storage position"
